

**Problem :** Buy, Sell and Short Buttons in Level II Order Entry Window Appear to be Spaced Disproportionately Too Far Apart

**Error Message /  
Description:**

Level II Order Entry window: Spacing between the Buy, Sell and Short (**SHRT**, **SELL** and **BUY**) buttons at the upper-center of the Level II Order Entry window appears to be too far apart, disproportionate to their size. It just doesn't "look right" – as if something is askew.

**Solution:**

This is actually a Microsoft Windows desktop display configuration issue; it is caused by Large Fonts having been selected in the desktop's display settings. The solution to this display problem is to change the desktop's default Font size from Large to **Small Fonts**. This is done in the following manner:

1. Right-click empty space on desktop; select **Properties**.
2. Click on the **Settings** tab, then go to the **Advanced** button.
3. Click on the **General** tab
4. In the "Display: Font Size" pull-down menu bar at the upper-left corner of this window, select **Small Fonts**.
5. Click "**OK**."

You will be prompted to re-boot your computer to make this change go into effect on your desktop display.

After re-booting and re-opening Sterling Trader Pro, when you next observe the Buy, Sell and Short (**SHRT**, **SELL** and **BUY**) buttons at the upper-center of the Level II Order Entry window, the spacing between the buttons will now be minimal, proportionate to size.
